

Unclaimed Restitution

Per Augrey Lyons of the CJCC, there is no form for remitting unclaimed restitution. The CJCC does, however, have steps they would like followed when remitting unclaimed restitution:

1. Make the check payable to:

2. Checks should represent ONLY unclaimed restitution monies. The check stub should specify who the unclaimed restitution monies are payable to, the last known address, the date the funds were first available to the payee and the docket number.
3. If payments need to be made to the victims of violent crime (regular restitution), then there should be a separate check, listing who the offender is and/or the crime victim and the victim's compensation claim number, if known.
4. Note: Unclaimed restitution is held in a separate account. Therefore, if you are remitting unclaimed restitution and additional funds to the GA Crime Victim Emergency fund, unclaimed restitution must be paid with a separate check.
